WHAT ARE THE GUIDELINES?

- Only digital images, emailed as jpeg attachments (maximum 3MB per email), are eligible.
- Quality of each photo must be more than 300DPI
- Up to four images can be submitted, each with a short caption (30-50 words).
- Winners will be featured during the conference and APACPH/ECN websites. Certificates will be awarded to the winners and certificate of participation will be awarded to all participants

Send each photo separately and include in your message the following:

- Name of photographer
- Photographer affiliation (email and phone)
- Title of each photograph
- Location (city and country where photograph was taken)
- Category of photo (Choose from categories above)
- The date (if unknown, please provide the year) each photograph was taken (Photo must be taken in the last two years)
- This affirmation for images containing faces that are capable of being recognized: “For this photo I asked for and received from those in the photograph verbal (at a minimum) consent to be photographed.”
